Ash Wednesday
First day of Lent. It has been observed in the Christian church since the 9th century, and owes its name to the use of ashes in the Roman Catholic church.

Assumption
Act of taking the souls of the dead to heaven. The chief use of the word is for the assumption of the Virgin Mary, this being a festival in the Roman Catholic Church held on Aug 15.
